The easiest way to travel to Cadogan Hall is by public transport. It is located within two minutes' walk of Sloane Square London Underground Station, which is served by the District and Circle lines, and is one stop away from Victoria Railway Station, which has mainline and additional London Underground connections.



Turn right out of the Underground Station, cross Cliveden Place and walk up Sedding Street to the Hall. Frequent bus services stop in Sloane Square and neighbouring streets, including King's Road, Sloane Street and Lower Sloane Street.

Bus services include numbers: 11, 19, 22, 137, 211, 319, 360 and C1.

Taxis are numerous in the area and there is a taxi rank located in Sloane Square opposite the Underground Station.

Customers are reminded that on-street parking is strictly controlled, with the nearest car park located half a mile away in Cadogan Place to the North.
